## 115 & Primm

Las Vegas Blvd (LVB) runs a few hundred feet to the east of, and somewhat parallel to, I-15, from North Las Vegas to the California state line at Primm, where it becomes the resorts' and outlet mall's perimeter road. Note that from Jean to Primm, it's mostly a dirt road.

**Seven Magic Mountains** is 25 miles from Downtown Las Vegas and is only accessible from LVB. Interchanges on I-15 are 8 miles north in Sloan, or 6 miles south in Jean.

Primm is home to three casino resorts - Whiskey Pete's is closed. Buffalo Bill's is open occasionally for special events. There's large truck stops on each side, a mostly empty Prizm managed outlet mall, and the famous Lottery store. Famous because Nevada doesn't have a lottery, so locals come here to get their lottery fix. It's accessible only from the perimeter road, has a Nevada mailing address, but is located on the California side of the state line.

The trip south on I-15 is normally a nice relaxing ride, except weekly when Southern California visitors are heading home after a weekend trip. Traffic can be hours long as three lanes become two at the Primm interchange, and remains that way for six miles, until passing a California agricultural checkpoint.
